

Lesson 2: Motivation

8 mins	<p style="text-align: center;">Put the quotes around the room.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Put students in pairs and ask them to walk around and read the quotes and discuss the following:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">- Do you like the quote? Why/Why not?</p>
5 mins	<p style="text-align: center;">Give ss Handout 1 (FOLDED) and tell them to discuss the questions in groups.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Elicit answers from students</p>
3 mins	<p style="text-align: center;">Instruct students to unfold the next part page.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Instruct students to answer the question alone: Why are you learning English?</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Elicit answers.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Note: Most of them will say ‘because I have to’</p>
4 mins	<p style="text-align: center;">Instruct students to unfold the last part of the page.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Instruct students to answer the question alone: Why do you want to learn English.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Tell them you understand it is as difficult question to answer and to use the pictures to help them.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Note: The aim here is to help the students find something that English would help them do e.g. travel, watch a film in English, talk to people from other countries.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Elicit Feedback</p>
15 mins	<p style="text-align: center;">Ask the class the following question: <i>Is it easy to stay motivated?</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Give students Handout 2</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Split the students into groups and instruct them to use the imperative write eight tips to stay motivated (in general or when learning English)</p>
5 mins	<p style="text-align: center;">Put students in different groups and instruct them to share some of their tips.</p>
