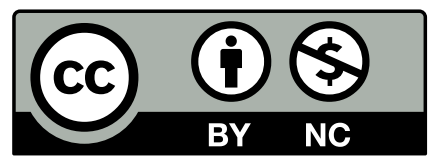

How do we form the -ing?

- *smile* ➡ remove the 'e' and add -ing ➡ **smiling**
- *sit* ➡ double the last consonant (t) and add -ing ➡ **sitting**

Note: we double the last consonant when the last three letters are consonant, vowel consonant e.g. **s i t**, except when the last letter is **w, y** or **z**.

- *work / look* ➡ add -ing ➡ **working / looking**
